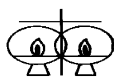

Palm Sunday

Dear friends: With this Sunday we begin Holy Week. Palm Sunday records the triumphant entry into Jerusalem, the place where He would suffer and be condemned to death. It was the practice for kings after victory to enter the city on horseback. Jesus instead enters on the colt of a donkey. Does this not say something to our heart?
